"ORDER"

In reference to "Admission Procedure of Private unaided educational institutions" Hon'ble Apex court held in P.A. Imandar's case that:-

" It needs to be specifically stated that having regard to the larger interest and welfare of the student community to promote merit, achieve excellence and curb malpractices, it would be permissible to regulate admissions by providing a centralised and single-window procedure. Such a Procedure, to a large extent, can secure grant of merit-based admissions on a transparent basis. Till regulations are framed, the admission Committees can oversee admissions so as to ensure that merit is not the casualty."

To ensure the above Objective, the government is pleased to order that In addition to the earlier order of this department No. F 6(12)ME/Gr.-1 dated 12.01.2009, the Admission Committee shall also monitor and regulate the entire Admission Procedure to ensure protection of the interest of student community as a whole and ensure of compliance of directions given by Hon'ble Supreme Court from time to time.
