**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-rule (1) of rule 17 of the Rajasthan Educational Service Rules, 1970, the State Government hereby prescribes the scheme of examination and the syllabus for the examination for direct recruitment for the post of Coach as follows :-

(1) It shall come into force with effect from 29 June 2011,

**Scheme and syllabus of competitive examination for the post of Coach:-**

(2) The examination shall carry 450 marks and maximum 40 marks shall be awarded for participation in sports/tournaments. (as per "Note I, II and III mentioned below the item number 5 of the part B of Paper II in Schedule II appended to the Rajasthan Educational Subordinate Service Rules, 1971.)

(3) There will be two papers. Paper I shall be of 150 marks and Paper II shall be of 300 marks. Duration of the Paper I shall be One and a Half Hours and the duration of Paper II shall be Three Hours.

(4) All the questions in both papers shall be Multiple Choice Type questions.

(5) Negative marking shall be applicable in the evaluation of answers. For every wrong answer one third of the marks prescribed for that particular question shall be deducted.

Explanation : Wrong answer shall mean an incorrect answer or multiple answers.

(6) Subjects included in both the papers and the marks given to them are shown in the table below :

**Paper - I General Studies**

Duration : 1 Hours and 30 minutes

**SUBJECTS**

1	History of Rajasthan and Indian history with special emphasis on Indian National movement.
2	Mental Ability Test, Statistics (Secondary Level), Mathematics (Secondary Level), Language ability test :- Hindi, English.
3	Current Affairs
4	General Science, Indian Polity, Geography of Rajasthan.

**Paper - II Sports Concerned**

Duration : 3 Hours

**SUBJECTS**

1	Knowledge of Physical Education & Sports.
2	Sports Science.
3	General Theory and Method of Training.
4	Specific Knowledge of Games/Sports and its current affairs.
